SERVICES:

Services offered to ALL people that have the ability to reproduce whether they desire to become pregnant or to become a parent.

- Women's Health Wellness and GYN services
 - BP, Breast exams, Pap and Co-testing, STI, Vax, preconception, concerns about breast, lesions on genital area, menstrual, vaginal, urinary issues
 - All BCM methods such as all LARC's (IUD's, Implant), shot, pills, patch, ring, condoms, natural family planning, EC
- Men's Health related to Reproductive and Sexual Health Services
 - BP, STI, Vax, concerns about burning during urination and ejaculation, discharge, lesions
- All patients are screen for drug use, alcohol use, nicotine/tobacco use, exercise, caffeine and mental health
- Collaboration and referral from DOH for syphilis, GC/CT treatments, TB and other communicable diseases

Clinical Statistics

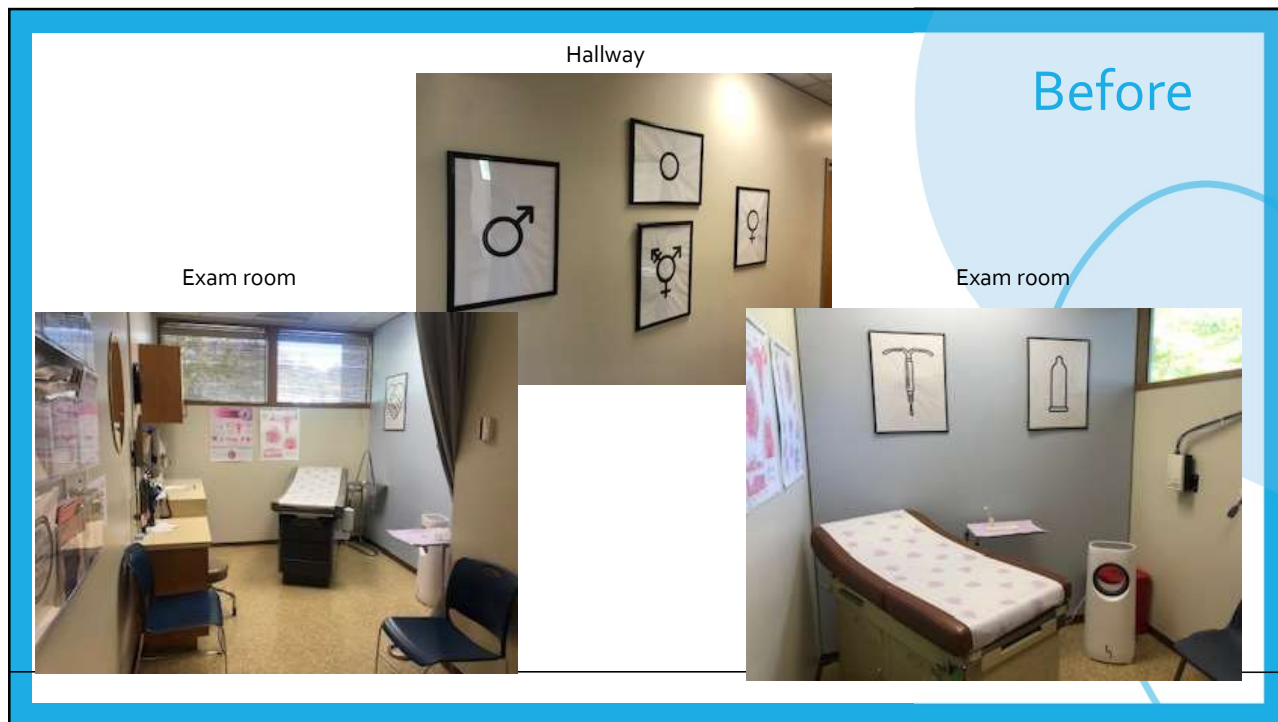
- 40% Spanish speaking only
- Insurance:
 - Medicaid 70%
 - Private insurance 25%
 - No charge (slide to zero) 2%
 - Partial fee 1%

- Birth Control Methods:
 - Shot 40%
 - Pills 20%
 - Implant 12.5%
 - IUD 6%
 - Condoms 6%
 - None 5.5%
 - Patch 4%
 - Rings 3.5%
